Employment Readiness Program

Employment Orientation

Learn about local area job opportunities, job search strategies, Military Spouse and Veteran preferences to jump start your job search. Session includes resume guidance, Military Spouse Preference (PPP-S) and career planning. Must attend this class to be eligible for career counseling, resume review, job referrals and all individualized assistance.

ABCs of Federal Employment

Learn how federal hiring process works and how to prepare your federal resume for success in each stage of review.

Corporate Resume Preparation

This class provides guidance on how to target your resume to local area private industry opportunities.

Kelly Services Recruiting/Express Pros Recruiting

Family Advocacy Program

Baby Bundles

Designed to give new and expecting parents information about postpartum expectations, infant care, as well as information on how to manage a family budget when a new baby arrives.

Cloth Diapering & Baby Wraps

Come and join other parents while learning about the benefits of cloth diapering. This class will review the different types of diapers and how the laundry cloth diapers. Participants will also develop skills and techniques on baby wraps, safety, positioning and different styles of carrying a wrapped baby.

Parenting with Love & Logic

This program uses humor, hope, and empathy to build-up the adult-child relationship, and emphasizes respect and dignity for both you and your children. You will learn to provide real limits in a loving way.

Play Morning

A parent and child play group that provides socialization for parents and children ages 5 and under. Play mornings allow children the opportunity to interact with each other through crafts, story time, play, and music, while parents can build networks and find support.

Rules of Engagement

This class will help you to identify your own needs and behaviors, learn effective and active listening skills, understand different communication styles in your relationship, explore barriers to effective communication and discover how to best handle conflict resolution in your own relationships.

Single Parent Support Group

This *non-clinical* support group is a great way to meet other single parents who may be experiencing similar stressors. This groups can help you connect, vent and find solutions to issues you may be working through.
