# Winter Weather Guidance

As the winter season approaches it's important to keep safety procedures in mind, as well as the operating status of CYS during times of inclement weather. During inclement weather, please keep children home, whenever possible, to reduce the risk of driving during hazardous road conditions. To assist in compensation during these days, CYS will grant discount credit points (WIN points) for patrons who voluntarily keep their child(ren) at home. These credits, combined with other parent participation credits will gain you up to 10% off your account for one month.

While Fort Belvoir generally follows Federal Government (OPM) guidance, the Installation Commander may choose to make other decisions based on Fort Belvoir specific conditions.
