

START TIME: Saturday anytime between 9 a.m. and 1 p.m. Participants must finish the walk by 3 p.m.

SANCTIONED BY: The American Volkssport Association (AVA) is a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV) and the Northern Virginia Volksmarchers. Participants in this event may receive credit towards IVV awards.

ELIGIBILITY: This Volksmarch welcomes families, and individuals, and is open to DoD ID Cardholders and their sponsored visitors/guests who must be pre-cleared to enter post. All participants must read and sign a waiver before beginning the event. The signature of a parent or guardian is required for participants under the age of 18. Children 12 years and under must be accompanied by an adult.

PARKING: Parking is located across Goethals Road, opposite from the festival grounds. Please follow signs.

START/FINISH: Across the street to the festival grounds, Goethals Road and Constitution Road.

DISTANCE: One 11K (6.2 mile) route and one 6K (3.1 mile) route will be available.

GPS COORDINATES: 38 degrees 41' 43" N Latitude 077 degrees 09' 43" W Longitude.

IVV BOOKS: IVV Event and Distance Books will be sold at the Start/Finish area. Those who have participated in previous sanctioned events are reminded to bring their IVV Books for credit.

PROCEDURE: Check in at the start table and sign a waiver. After completing the Volksmarch, return to the Finish Table and report-in for accountability purposes and stamping of IVV Books, if desired.

FEE*: IVV Credit only \$4 if desired. Participation is \$2. Register same day only.

EVENT CONDITIONS: This event is rain or shine with the exception of extreme weather. The route can accommodate strollers and wagons; however, they may require portaging over road curbs. The route is unsuitable for wheelchairs. Dress in appropriate attire, wear sturdy footwear and bring extra water. Porta jons are at the start/finish area; facilities with restrooms are along the route.

REFRESHMENTS: You are encouraged to bring your own water or drink for the route. Water will be available at the START/FINISH area. You may also purchase food and drink at the festival grounds which open at 12 p.m.

DISCLAIMER: The American Volkssport Association or its subsidiary clubs are not responsible for theft or loss of personal belongings or property. All participants must sign a waiver at the time of registration.

ROUTE DESCRIPTION:

This event's planned route takes you along sidewalks, paths, trails and post roads on Fort Belvoir's North Post.

DIRECTIONS: From I-95 North, take Exit 166A (Newington/Fort Belvoir). Turn right onto Backlick Road/Fairfax County Parkway. Turn left on Route 1 (Richmond Highway). Turn right on Pohick Road (1st traffic light) and enter Fort Belvoir through Tulley Gate. Follow Oktoberfest road signs to your destination. From I-95 South take the Exit 166A (Newington/Fort Belvoir). Merge onto Backlick Road/Fairfax County Parkway. From here, follow the directions for I-95 N.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: All pets must be on a leash on the route; pets are not allowed in the festival area. Participants must remove their pet's waste from the route. Smoking is prohibited.
