## 2021 Operation Sugarplum Recipient Application

- 3. COMPLETE ONE MANDATORY FINANCE COURSE
  - a. The applicant must register and complete their selected finance courses to receive assistance.
  - b. A spouse may attend the course as a substitute for the Service Member.
  - c. The virtual workshops will be administered through Zoom.
- 4. There are <u>ONE</u> major Holiday Assistance Programs offered to Families on Fort Belvoir; Operation Sugarplum and Project USO Elf. To ensure all eligible Families who need support are given an opportunity to receive gifts or assistance during this holiday season applicants may only participate in <u>ONE</u> of these programs.
