A. Through a variety of classes, programs and services, Fort Belvoir Aquatics focuses on fitness, health, safety and leisure. Fort Belvoir Aquatics operates a year-round facility and two seasonal facilities.

Benyaurd Indoor Pool offers a year-round, six-lane, 25-yard lap pool with a variety of water exercise equipment. Programs and services include group and private swim lessons, lifeguard and water safety instructor training, scuba classes, and is an excellent venue for your next pool party! In addition, the facility participates in the annual Commander's Cup by hosting the Intramural Swim Meet.

Connolly Outdoor Pool Complex is a seasonal, saltwater facility that offers a large recreational pool, a four-lane lap pool and a baby pool. In addition, the complex offers group and private swim lessons, scuba classes, and is a popular venue for pool parties during the summer! The complex also hosts the much-anticipated Float-in Movies and an annual Pooch Plunge, weather permitting.

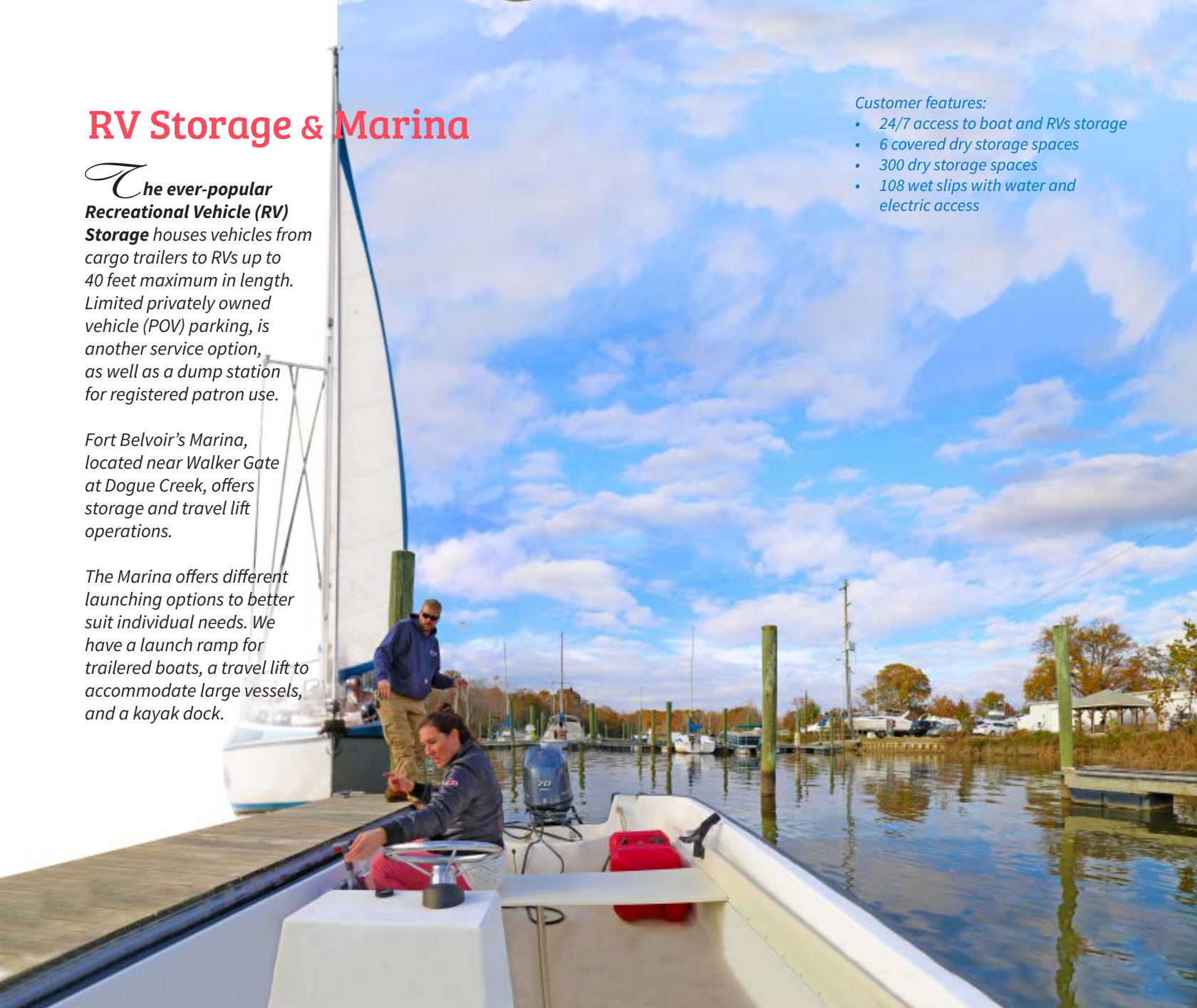
RV Storage & Marina

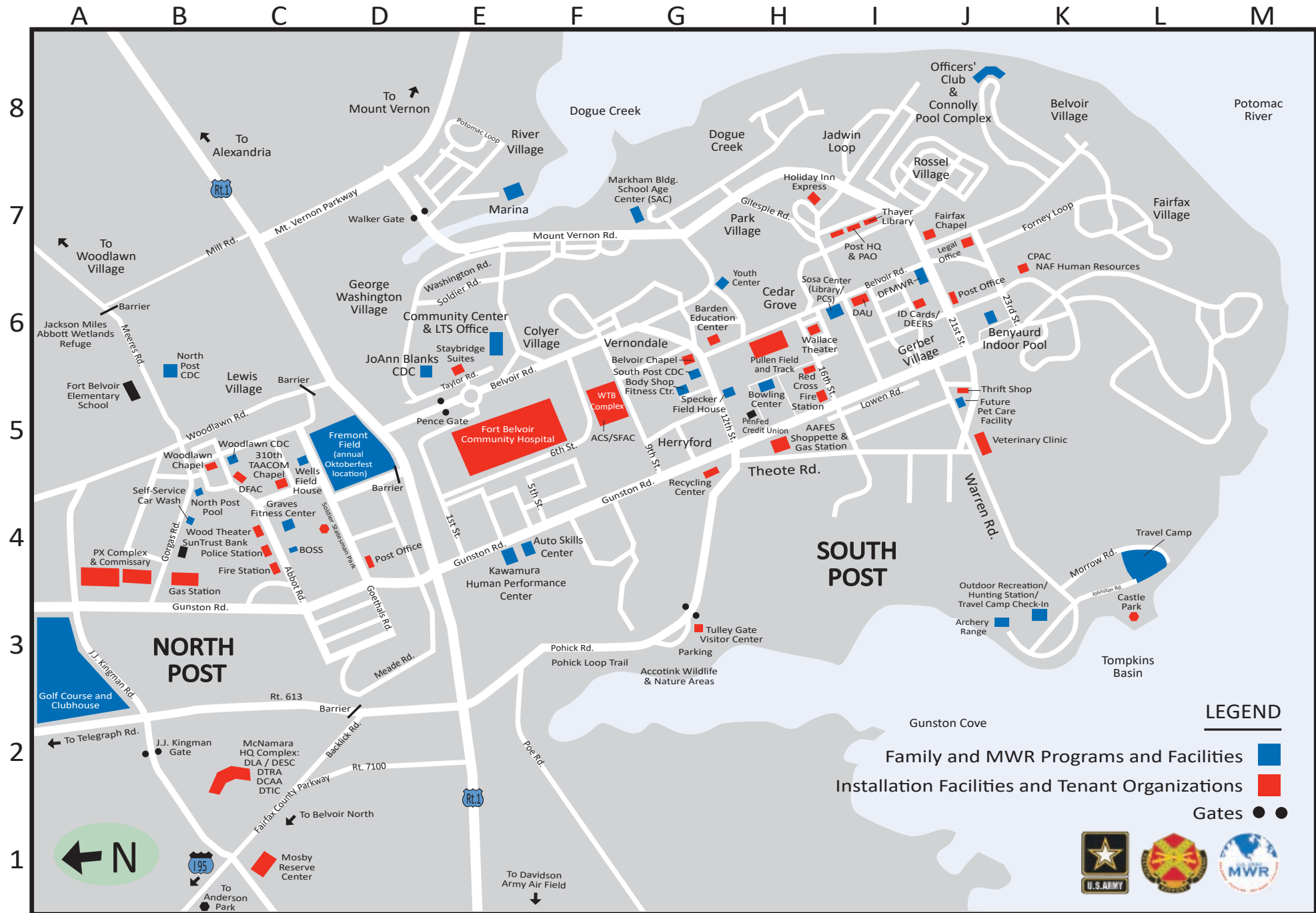
